

Pregnancy Complications

Cephalic- baby presents with normal head down position.

Limb- baby has arm or leg hanging out of cervix.

Breech- baby is positioned in reverse with gluteus maximus in the birth canal.

Prolapsed Cord- umbilical is hanging out of cervix before baby.

Ectopic- zygote tries to develop in fallopian tube instead of uterus.

Placenta Previa- Placenta forms over the cervix.

Abruptio Placentae- the placenta rips from the uteral wall before delivery of baby.

Pre-eclampsia- Mother experiences swelling and hypertension(high blood pressure) during pregnancy.

Meconium Staining- green/brown stain indicating that the baby defecated (pooped) in the amniotic fluid.

Spontaneous Abortion- miscarriage
